
Call the Rectory at least four weeks before the baptism. Baptismal instruction for the parents and God-parents is required.

**ASSUMPTION OF MARY  
HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION  
AUGUST 15, 2014**

**Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes at 7AM and 7PM**

All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (January 1) on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (December 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin. Her whole being throbbled with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother of the Savior.

The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

The feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationships with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.

The prayer for the feast reads: "All powerful and ever-living God: You raised the sinless virgin Mary, mother of your Son, body and soul, to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory."

**We also have a phone app option!** Please keep in mind that you have to have your email listed in the directory for this to work, that being said, if you do not have it listed, (you will know after step 6 below) Pam would be happy to add any email (cpaubry@mchsi.com). The directions for the phone app are as follows:

1. Go to the app store (Apple Appstore, Google Play or Amazon Appstore)
2. Go to the search
3. Type in Instant Church Directory and the app should come up
4. Tap it to download it to your phone
5. Tap open
6. You will now have to put in your email that is listed in the church directory and they will send you an email with the password, check your email!
7. Click back on the little church app that is now on the screen of your phone and it should take you back to where they asked you for a password.
8. Put the password they sent you in the email and click done. It should pull up everything that has been entered. If you click on someone's name it makes it bigger and it will list the address, etc.
