


Devotion for the Month of May

Here are some names/places Mother Mary has appeared and received her various names due to her many apparitions. Please take time this week to research some of these Marian apparitions. Will you study the Marian Apparitions of Our Lady? Will you listen to her messages and respond? Will you fast, do penance, and pray especially, pray the Holy Rosary! Pray the rosary every day to obtain the peace for the world and the end of the war."

- *Our Lady of Lourdes/Queen of Peace = Lourdes, France (Correction from last week)
- *Our Lady of Fatima/Immaculate Heart of Mary= Fatima, Portugal
- *Our Lady of Loreto and the Holy House=Loreto, Italy
- *Our Lady of Ocotlan=Txcala, Mexico
- *Our Lady of Pompeii/Our Lady of the Rosary=Valley of Pompeii/ Naples, Italy
- *Our Lady of Tears=Campinas, São Paulo, Brazil
- *Our Lady Gate of Dawn/Black Madonna =Vilnius; Lithuania
- *Our Lady of Peace/ Lady of the Conquest / The Lady Conqueror=La Conquistadora, New Mexico. USA
- *Our Lady of Pilar=Zaragoza, Spain (The only recorded instance of Mother Mary exhibiting the mystical phenomenon of bilocation. It is also considered the first Marian apparition, and unique because it happened while Mary was still living on Earth to St. John the Apostle)
- *Our Lady of the Rosary/Our Lady of Victory=Straits of Lepanto, Gulf of Patras, Ionian Sea, Basin countries, Greece
- *Our Lady of Garabandal/ Our Lady of Mount Carmel/Queen of Peace = Village of San Sebastian de Garabandal in the mountains, Northern Spain
