
A PRAYER FOR ALL VETERANS On Memorial Day, May 30, 2022

O God, Great and Almighty creator, we thank and praise You for the freedom we enjoy in our country and pray that our liberties will continue to be protected.


Thank you for America's heroes, that have fought for our freedoms and who have faithfully served our country. We honor all of our veterans, for their sacrifices and for their courage and integrity.

Daily Reflections from the
Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

Infinite Value for Souls

Today, during Mass, I (**St. Faustina**) saw the Lord Jesus in the midst of His sufferings, as though dying on the cross. He (**Jesus**) said to me, My daughter, (**St. Faustina**) meditate frequently on the sufferings which I (**Jesus**) have undergone for your sake, and then nothing of what you (**St. Faustina**) suffer for Me (**Jesus**) will seem great to you. You (**St. Faustina**) please Me (**Jesus**) most when you meditate on My Sorrowful Passion. Join your (**St. Faustina**) little sufferings to My Sorrowful Passion, so that they (**St. Faustina sufferings**) (**and our sufferings**) may have infinite value before My (**Jesus**) Majesty (Diary, 1512). (**Prayer**) Lord Jesus, may I meditate frequently on the sufferings of Your Passion. May I join my little sufferings to Your sorrowful Passion that they may have infinite value for souls.

Please try to **pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm** for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take at least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven every day at 3:00pm for the whole world.
