

Daily Reflections from the
Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska

The Work of Redemption

(Jesus) Listen, My daughter (**St. Faustina**), although all the works that come into being by My will are exposed to great sufferings, consider whether any of them has been subject to greater difficulties than that work which is directly Mine (**Jesus**) — the work of Redemption. You should not worry too much about adversities. The world is not as powerful as it seems to be; its strength is strictly limited (Diary, 1643).

(Prayer) Lord Jesus, may I not worry and lose my peace when I face difficulties in promoting Your mercy to souls in need. May I be inspired in the struggle by the words of the Great Mercy Pope: “The ultimate limit to evil is Divine Mercy”
(see **Pope John Paul II**, *Memory and Identity*, pg 55)

Please try to **pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm** for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take at least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven every day at 3:00pm for the whole world.
