





October- the Month of “Holy Rosary”

He (**Andrea Doria**) carried a small copy of Mexico's Our Lady of Guadalupe into battle. This image is now enshrined in the Church of San Stefano in Aveto, Italy. Not many know that at the Monastery of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Spain, one can view a huge warship lantern that was captured from the Moslems in the Battle of Lepanto. In Rome, look up to the ceiling of Saint Maria in Aracoeli and behold decorations in gold taken from the Turkish galleys. In the Doges' Palace in Venice, Italy, one can witness a giant Islamic flag that is now a trophy from a vanquished Turkish ship from the Victory.

With Freshness of Heart

The Lord said to me (**Saint Faustina**), I (**Jesus**) am delighted with your love. Your sincere love is as pleasing to My Heart (**Jesus**) as the fragrance of a rosebud at morning tide before the sun has taken the dew from it. The freshness of your heart captivates Me; that is why I (**Jesus**) unite Myself with you (**Saint**

Faustina) more closely than with any other creature ... (Diary, 1546). Then I (**Saint Faustina**) heard the words: As you are united with Me (**Jesus**) in life, so will you be united at the moment of death. After these words, such great trust in God’s great mercy was awakened in my (**Saint Faustina**) soul that, even if I had had the sins of the whole world, as well as the sins of all the condemned souls weighing on my conscience, I would not have doubted God’s goodness but, without hesitation, would have thrown myself (**Saint Faustina**) into the abyss of the divine mercy, which is always open to us ... (Diary, 1552).

(Prayer) Lord Jesus, help me to love You with freshness of heart that will delight You. Help me to abandon myself totally to Your holy will, which is mercy itself. Let me never doubt Your great mercy.

Please try to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet every day at 3:00pm for this is when Our Lord Jesus Christ gave us his life for sins. If you cannot pray at that time, take at least a moment at 3:00pm to feel the inconceivable, abundant Mercy that falls from heaven every day at 3:00pm for the whole world. Jesus, I Trust In You!
