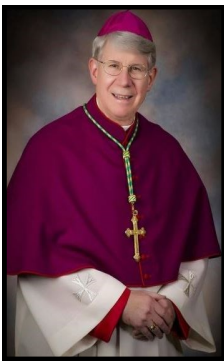

In our homes and in our nation, lead us to Him Who alone wins the victory over sin and darkness in us and in the world.

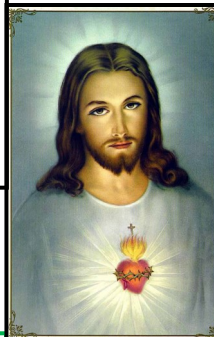
