**Your Resting Place** 

I heard a voice coming from the Host: Here is My repose. During Benediction, Jesus gave me to know that soon a solemn moment would take place on this very spot. I am pleased to rest in your heart and nothing will stop Me from granting you graces. This greatness of God floods my soul, and I drown in Him, I lose myself in Him, I am melting away in Him ... (Diary, 1136).

June 1, 1937. Today, the Corpus Christi procession took place. At the first altar, a flame issued from the Host and pierced my heart, and I heard a voice, Here is My resting place (Diary, 1140).

During Holy Mass, which was celebrated by Father Andrasz, I saw the Infant Jesus who, with hands outstretched toward us, was sitting in the chalice being used at Holy Mass. After gazing at me penetratingly, He spoke these words: As you see Me in this chalice, so I dwell in your heart (Diary, 1346).

Lord Jesus, dwell in my heart as Your resting place. May nothing in me stop You from granting me graces.


**Reflection Two** —— Am I not here, I who have the honor to be your mother? Are you not in my shadow and under my protection? Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantle, in the crossing of my arms? Do you need anything more? Our Lady spoke these most consoling words to Juan Diego at a deeply sorrowful moment. Juan Diego had failed to meet our Lady's request, and his uncle, Juan Bernardino, whom he loved dearly, was near death. We are reminded through the tradition of Holy Mother Church that Our Lady was no stranger to sorrow: the Church names seven particular sorrows of Mary, and praying the Rosary draws us into contemplation of five Sorrowful Mysteries in which she participated with all her heart. We know, too, that her Son, Our Lord, also felt great sorrow. We read in Scripture that Jesus wept over Jerusalem, that he wept at the death of Lazarus, that he perspired blood in the Garden of Gethsemane. And we know from the studies of the Word of God by the Church Fathers that Christ felt the full weight of sorrow for our sins during His Passion and Death. We will never escape sorrow in this world: indeed, Our Lady followed Our Lord's will perfectly, and even she was beset by sorrows that we cannot imagine. But we must never let this sorrow devolve into fear, nor into despair. We must embrace sorrow as an opportunity to grow closer to Christ, to offer up our suffering and thereby


unite our lives more closely with His. Does He not teach us that to be one with Him we must take up our cross daily and follow Him? And if the suffering in this world ever grows so great that we feel we cannot bear it, we must not hesitate, even for a moment, to call out to Our Blessed Mother, who will not fail to keep us safe "in the hollow of her mantle, in the crossing of her arms." Let us pray...
